


LTVB presents a comical look behind the curtain with It's Only a Play

It matches wit with playwrights like Ken Ludwig and Michael Frayn who have written shows about what happens backstage in the theater. This tells the story of the narcissism that happens even after the actors leave the backstage.

It's Only A Play is so carefully structured that no one is competing for a laugh or elbowing each other out of the way. They all have their moment. I have seven incredible actors who each bring a unique style of comedy to the table. The greatest humor comes from the greatest truth. It's Only A Play is the greatest representation.




