THEATER ETIQUETTE

- Arrive early: Plan to arrive at least 15 minutes before the show starts to ensure you have enough time to find your seat
- Turn off your phone: Using your phone during a performance can be distracting to the audience and the performers
- Be quiet: Don't talk or sing during the show
- **Don't take pictures**: Taking pictures or recording a professional production is illegal. The bright flash from your camera can also ruin the action
- Return on time from intermission: Make sure to return to your seat on time after intermission
- Stay seated: Don't fidget or leave your seat during the show
